



COVID - Conscious Precautions

What do I need to do before I come to the worship service or event?

Please check yourself and your family member's temperatures before coming to the service. If you don't feel well, for the safety of others please stay home and watch via livestream.

Has the building been cleaned and sanitized?

Yes. We are taking special precautions to make sure our buildings provide a clean and sanitized environment for worship.

Where do I enter?

Please enter through the glass sanctuary doors facing Judson Road or enter Trinity Hall for a viewing room (if applicable).

Do I have to wear a mask?

Masks are encouraged. If you don't have one to bring with you, masks and bandanas will be available in the foyer. Please take what you use home with you.

Do I need to bring my own hand sanitizer?

Hand sanitizer is readily available in multiple areas throughout the buildings.

What about hugs and handshakes?

Please be respectful of others who are uncomfortable with hugs and handshakes right now. You can love others well even with a smile and a wave!

Where do I sit?

Every other row will be closed. Bulletins are located on each row and are placed to indicate where individuals or families may sit while maintaining a safe distance from others. Families may sit all together on the same row. There are extra bulletins located at the sound booth if needed. Please take what you use home with you or dispose of them upon leaving.

What if I am uncomfortable being in the sanctuary but want to be with my faith family?

On-site viewing rooms are available in the Sanctuary building and Trinity Hall. You can reserve a viewing room for you or your family by emailing info@epclongview.org.

What if I'm not ready to be with others or if I have a compromised immune system? Will I be able to worship from home?

Yes. Livestream services will continue and recordings will be available after each service.

Will there be accommodation for children?

The Nursery will be staffed by volunteers for most Sunday worship services.

We will not have volunteers for the infants and toddlers for Christmas Eve and Dec. 27 or for most events or memorial services but the rooms will be available for families to use during the service. They have been cleaned and sanitized. The nursery will have audio available. The toddler room and Carlton room will have livestreaming video available.
