Invitation

What does "sacrament" mean? This morning we celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper (also called Communion). We get the word "sacrament" from the Latin sacramentum, which means "mystery" or "secret." Unlike those who believe the sacraments (baptism and the Lord's Supper) are merely rites to perform as commanded by Jesus, the Bible teaches that there is something more spiritually mysterious and profound about these two acts. The mystery is that Christ is uniquely present in these observances in a way that is like no other. They are beautiful yet mysterious encounters with Jesus Himself. For instance, in the Lord's Supper, we don't merely remember Christ's sacrifice, we mysteriously "participate" in it (see 1 Cor. 10:16). And in baptism, we do not merely depict salvation, we are actually united to Christ and His death (see Rom 6:4). Sacraments are more than mere ordinances, for in them we experience Christ Himself. Our veiled understanding of the details of how this occurs is precisely why they are, and ever will be, a mystery.
